BYLAW NO. 532, 2022

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE ALTERNATE MEANS OF PUBLISHING PUBLIC NOTICES

WHEREAS the Community Charter provides that Council may, by bylaw, provide for alternative means of publishing a public notice;

AND WHEREAS Council has considered the principles of reliability, suitability and accessibility as they apply to the means of publishing a public notice;

NOW, THEREFORE, Council of the Village of Silverton, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Title

This Bylaw may be cited as "Public Notice Bylaw No. 532, 2022".

2. Definitions

Village Office means the Village of Silverton Municipal Office located in Silverton, BC

Village Office Bulletin Board means the public notice posting place located at the Village Office

Municipal website means the Village of Silverton website

Village means the Village of Silverton

3. Advertising Method

- 3.1. Any notice required to be advertised in accordance with section 94 of the Community Charter may instead be given, in accordance with section 94.2 of the Community Charter, by publishing the notice once in a local newspaper, electronically posting a copy of the notice on the municipal website, and posting a copy of the notice at the Village Office Bulletin Board.

4. Effective Date

This bylaw shall take effect upon adoption.

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF SILVERTON

BYLAW NO. 533, 2022

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR ELECTIONS AND OTHER VOTING

The Council of the Village of Silverton, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Title

This Bylaw may be cited as "Election Procedures Bylaw No. 533, 2022".

2. Access to Nomination and Endorsement Documents

- 2.1. The chief election officer may give public access to nomination documents by the internet or other electronic means from the time of filing until 30 days after the declaration of the election results.
- 2.2. The chief election officer may give public access to elector organization endorsement documents by the internet or other electronic means from the time of filing until 30 days after the declaration of the election results.

3. Elector Registration

The most current available Provincial list of voters prepared under the Election Act shall form the register of resident electors and shall become the register of electors on the 52nd day prior to general voting day.

4. Advance Voting Opportunities

- 4.1. Required advance voting will be held in accordance with the Local Government Act.
- 4.2. The chief election officer may:
 - a. establish additional voting opportunities to be held in advance of general voting day; and
 - b. designate the voting places and set the voting hours for these voting opportunities.

5. Special Voting Opportunities

- 5.1. The chief election officer may establish the dates, locations, and voting hours within the limits set out in the Local Government Act, for the special voting opportunities.
- 5.2. The following restrictions apply as to who may vote at the special voting opportunities:
 - a. Only electors who, on the date on which the special voting opportunities are held, are residents or patients or family members thereof, or are employees of the facilities at which special voting opportunities are conducted.
- 5.3. The chief election officer is authorized to limit the number of candidate representatives who may be present at the special voting opportunities.

6. Mail Ballot Voting

- 6.1. Mail ballot voting shall be permitted in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act.

6.2. The chief election officer shall keep sufficient records so that challenges of the elector's right to vote may be made in accordance with the intent of section 126 of the Local Government Act.

6.3. The chief election officer shall determine the time limits in relation to voting by mail ballot.

7. Resolution of Tie Vote

7.1. In the event of a tie vote after a judicial recount, the tie vote will be resolved by conducting a lot in accordance with section 151 of the Local Government Act.

8. Repeal

Village of Silverton Elections Procedure Bylaw No. 470, 2011 and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed.

9. Effective Date

This bylaw shall take effect upon adoption.

CITATION

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Council Procedure Amendment (Electronic Meetings) Bylaw No. 531, 2022.

AMENDMENTS

2. Part 1 Section 2 – Definitions

Section 2 is amended by changing the definition of “Public Notice Posting Places” to read as follows:

means the notice board at the Village Office and the Village of Silverton website

3. Part 2 Section 8 – Electronic Meetings

Section 8 of the Procedure Bylaw is repealed and replaced in its entirety with the following:

8.
 - (1) A regular or special council meeting or other Council committee meeting may be conducted by electronic means
 - (2) Electronic meetings will follow the rules established by the Community Charter Section 128 and Council policies pertaining to electronic meetings.
 - (3) Advance public notice of meetings that are open to the public, will be posted in the public notice posting places according to the procedures established in this bylaw for giving notice, and will include:
 - (a) the way in which the electronic meeting will be conducted, and
 - (b) the place where the public may attend to hear, or watch and hear, the proceedings.

RE: Slocan Lake and River Partnership

Earlier this year, at the Community Sustainable Living Advisory Committee, Director Walter Popoff passed the following resolution to ``support an investigation of the Slocan Lake and River Partnership in 2022 with the goal of informed decision-making to ensure the area is best managed for ecological, social, and cultural values``.

As one of the 3 municipalities of Slocan Lake, I am reaching out to introduce the Slocan Lake and River Partnership (SLRP). I along with Chris Johnson and Paris Marshall Smith are the team leading this initiative. Below is a list providing the purpose, needs and role of the RDCK as it relates to this initiative.

PURPOSE of Slocan Lake and River Partnership

- convene Slocan Lake and River partners to influence development on the Lake and River; and,
- engage a stakeholder group to work with the partners.

NEED for the Slocan Lake and River Partnership

- guide development – current and future;
- protect ecosystems – aquatic and riparian;
- support implementation of the Foreshore Inventory Map (FIM) and any further mapping;
- support creation of Development Permit Areas (DPAs); and,
- support the Area H Official Community Plan (OCP).

RDCK's ROLE

- provide initial support to convene stakeholders and establish advisory group;
- support administration of group; and,
- provide seed funding to support coordination.

In June we would like to convene key partners for an initial discussion of the Slocan Lake and River Partnership. Would you like to contribute to the SLRP as the Partnership evolves? If so, please let us know in what capacity you would like to be involved.
