The Village of Silverton is located nearly 95 kilometers north of Nelson, nestled in the Slocan Valley and is situated on beautiful Slocan Lake.

Under the supervision of the Public Works Foreman, the Public Works (PW) Labourer will perform a wide variety of duties assigned by the PW Foreman and/or the CAO. You will be responsible for general maintenance duties, garbage pickup duties, snow plowing, completion of small water system qualifications, special/capital project duties and other day-to-day duties or other work that is required. This list is not exhaustive and is subject to change in accordance with the corporate needs.

The starting pay for this position is \$19.00 to \$23.00 per hour, depending on qualifications and experience. A six-month probation period will apply. This position is four days a week, 8 hours a day, and offers full benefits. Being on call after hours will occasionally be required.

The successful candidate should have:

- Completion of Secondary Education or equivalent.
- Valid BC Class 5 Driver's License with a clean abstract.
- WHMIS Certification
- General understanding of WorkSafe BC regulations and related work practices.
- Ability to use basic hand tools, both manual and electric.
- Ability to operate small gas and diesel powered equipment.
- Ability to work outdoors in all weather conditions.
- Sufficient physical strength, stamina, and coordination to do heavy manual labour, and the ability to withstand long periods of crouching, standing, bending, walking, climbing, lifting, etc.
- Ability to work unsupervised, when required.
- Ability to deal tactfully with other employees, contractors, and the general public.
