Silverton Residential Fall Cleanup Day 2022

Tuesday, Oct 11th - Thursday, Oct 13th

Acceptable Items

- Tree Trimmings / Branches. Must be piled neatly and branches separated to run through the chipper. Under 10cm in diameter and 3 meters in length.
- Leaves (bagged)
- Organic Materials

The Village of Silverton will only pick up organic materials placed out on or before October 13th. Any other non-organic materials will be left and will be the owner's responsibility to take them to the appropriate recycling facility or transfer station.

Place organic materials at end of the driveway to be processed

Fall clean-up services will be provided for residents of the Villages of Slocan, Silverton, and New Denver. Chipper and crew will be available to process and remove woody debris put out by property owners. Additional chipper and debris removal services are being provided by the Slocan Integral Forestry Cooperative (SIFCo) on behalf of the three Villages of Slocan, Silverton, and New Denver as part of the Slocan Valley Wildfire Resiliency Program. The

Slocan Valley Wildfire Resiliency Program is a multi-year initiative that incorporates the FireSmart disciplines to address; education, emergency planning, vegetation management, inter-agency cooperation, and cross-training with the context of better preparing communities for the threat of wildfire.
